**a PhD Position in Information Systems /  
Competence Center Corporate Data Quality (CC CDQ)**

starting on August, 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 or on a mutually agreed date.

The candidate will work in the Competence Center Corporate Data Quality (CC CDQ, [www.cc-cdq.ch](http://www.cc-cdq.ch)), an industry-funded consortium research program that is researching, developing and testing solutions that advance corporate data management in the digital age. CC CDQ is being conducted between leading research institutions and more than 15 renowned European companies. Current research activities focus on digitization and data-driven innovation, methodologies for managing data as an asset as well as future data supply chains and architectures (e.g. for Big Data analytics and Internet of Things).

The candidate will be employed as research assistant at HEC Lausanne. The employment rate is 100% and contract duration is one year. This contract is renewable twice for two years. The maximum duration is 5 years.

Applicants with the following qualifications will be considered for this position:

- Master's degree in Information Systems or related field
- Strong knowledge and research interest in topics related to digitization and data-driven services, business information systems and/or information modeling & architecture
- Practical experience (e.g. as consultant) and/or internships
- Excellent analytical and communication skills
- Ability to perform high quality research and willingness to complete a doctoral thesis in the area of Corporate Data Management
- Fluency in English; German or French are a plus

All applicants should submit their Curriculum Vitae, the names of two referees, their university transcripts (bachelor and master level) and an electronic version of a recent research project (e.g. master thesis, scientific publication).
